

Dear Greer Community Member,

In the past year, two issues related to the enforcement of Greer's zoning ordinance, Article 6, have been the subject of activity by Apache Co. officials. First, a proposal to use steel shipping containers for housekeeping units was judged to be a violation of the prohibition of 'manufactured housing'. This has created a desire on the part of County officials and the Greer community to further clarify definitions of 'Manufactured Housing'.

Second, Recreational Vehicles are prohibited under Article 6. This has prompted a number of proposals for RV possession, use and rental within Greer. There have been formal requests for Conditional Use Permits for RV possession and use in Greer.

There will be a public meeting in the Community Center on July 16th at 11 am. to hear the opinions of the Greer Community on these and several other clarifications of Article 6.

In this context, the Greer Coalition (GCI) a community group dedicated to studying land use issues within Greer, has created a survey on the key issues under discussion.

The goal is to collate Greer opinion and provide this to community members and County officials in this effort.
